In response to the 215 children buried unceremoniously at the Kamloops Residential School, Bloordale United Church has shared the following message:

A few of us have been sharing our grief and lament over the discovery of the remains of the 215 children at the Kamloops Residential School, and beyond the advocacy and action that we are asked to take up, including writing letters about the passage of Bill C-15, the implementation of the TRC Calls to Action, etc., we also wanted to undertake a more local expression of solidarity and support. **We invite people, from our own faith community,**

from other faith communities, and from the general public, to bring a pair of shoes and place them on our church's front steps as a means of making a public witness.


