“Film and Faith”

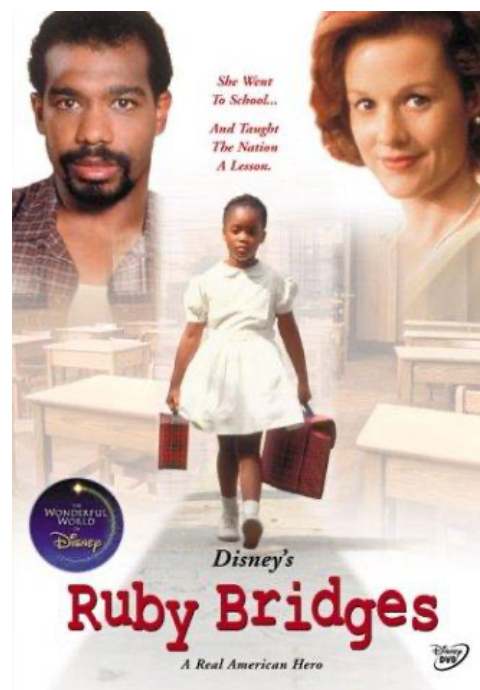
Friday, February 25th at 7pm – Disney’s Ruby Bridges

Movie Length: 90 minutes

Here is a description of the movie from “Reel Family Movies” (<https://www.cboqkids.ca/ruby/>):

This movie is based on the true story of Ruby Bridges and her experience at 6 years old as the first black girl to attend an all white school in New Orleans that was resistant to carry out the desegregation of school law that had been issued. It is an emotional and intense movie and has some disturbing scenes of yelling and name calling that may make this difficult for young children to watch. However, this is also a powerful movie to begin or continue conversations with kids about the history of racism in the United States and the ongoing experiences of racism that continue today. There is also a strong Christian message and faith in Jesus depicted in the story.
