Reiki I is a **prerequisite** for **Reiki II**. While Reiki I involve the laying-on-of-hands for healing, Reiki II involves facilitating healing from a distance by using a photograph and translating the energy into words, thoughts, feelings, beliefs and images. It can also be used to communicate with your own divine inner wisdom. Everyone is encouraged to learn Reiki I, yet Reiki II requires spiritual maturity. While Reiki is not a religion, nor associated with any religious philosophy, it is spiritual in nature.

- * heighten your appreciation of the gift and power of Reiki
- * enable you to communicate with your own and others Higher Wisdom for healing
- * offer two attunements
- * provide opportunity for practice and support.
